## Lateral window sinus floor elevation with simultaneous implant placement

## **Patient History**

Patient had a missing tooth, and the immediate bone area has undergone a resorption, expanding the sinus cavity. The condition was to be treated with an implant and a sinus lift to achieve enough bone mass to hold the device.

## **Process & Conclusion**


With the lateral window carved, an implant was placed immediately and the cavity, preventively lined with a collagen membrane, filled with InterOss®. No adverse events were recorded during healing, and the granules did not perforate the sinus membrane.


